# EB-5 Regional Centers Must File Form I-924A by December 29

## EB-5 Regional Centers Must File Form I-924A by December 29 <sup>[1]</sup>

USCIS reminds all approved EB-5 regional centers with a designation letter dated on or before Sept. 30, 2015, that they must file [Form I-924A, Supplement to Form I-924](#)<sup>[2]</sup>, for fiscal year 2015 no later than Dec. 29, 2015.

Regional centers are required to submit Form I-924A every year to demonstrate continued eligibility for the regional center designation. See 8 CFR 204.6(m)(6).

Regional centers may be terminated for:

? Failure to provide USCIS with required information (which includes failing to file the required annual Form I-924A).

? Failure to promote economic growth.

A regional center that has been terminated from the EB-5 program may not solicit, generate or promote investors or investments, or otherwise participate as a designated regional center in connection with the Immigrant Investor Program.

There is no filing fee for Form I-924A. USCIS has posted [filing tips](#)<sup>[3]</sup>.
