DS-160 and additional forms [1]

When I apply for a nonimmigrant visa using the online DS-160, are additional forms required?

ANSWER:

No. The online DS-160 application replaced the DS-156, DS-157, DS-158, and DS-3032, which are no longer necessary. **NOTE:** In addition to the DS-160, Treaty Trader/Treaty Investor visa applicants also must complete an additional form (see the [Treaty Trader/Treaty Investor, E Visa Applicants](#) [2] section below for more information). Only applicants for K, N, S, T, or U visas should use the DS-156 application form (see the [Visa Categories Not Using the DS-160](#) [3] section below for more information).
