ANSWER:

Yes, you can reprint the confirmation page of an application that has already been submitted. In order to do so, go into the [Consular Electronic Application Center website](#) [2] and select the Embassy or Consulate at which you are applying. Hit ?Option C-Retrieve Application? on the Getting Started page and enter your application ID number. From there you will be able to view and print your confirmation page.
