Atlanta National Processing Center Will No Longer Forward PERM Case Requests to BALCA ^[1]

U.S. Department of Labor, ETA-Office of Foreign Labor Certification Announcement:

As of October 27, 2014, the Atlanta National Processing Center has changed its process and will no longer automatically forward to BALCA all PERM case Requests for Reconsideration where the original case decision was upheld. Rather, a Notice of Decision will be issued when the case is upheld, and the employer must affirmatively request review before BALCA no later than 30 calendar days after the date the Notice of Decision is issued. FAQs now reflect this change in process ^[2].
